





### DESCRIPTION

Emergency eyewash, for wall mounting, supplied with stainless steel bowl, stay-open full flow ball valve; activated by stainless steel push handle; heavy duty wall mounting plate, twin spray heads with dust caps.

### INSTALLATION

Review drawing (as shown on other side) to assure proper installation. The unit should be mounted to a structural member that will ensure structural rigidity. Use appropriate wall anchors and be sure the wall bracket is level to ensure proper flow pattern and to avoid unnecessary water spillage. Connect a water supply to the unit (use pipe sealant on all joints) that is a 1/2"minimum uninterrupted source of potable water. Failure to use potable water can result in emergency units producing impure or contaminated water causing possible further injury. The drain tailpiece or waste should be connected to an adequate drain in compliance with local plumbing codes.

### **OPERATION**

The eyewash is activated by pushing the push handle back 90°. The unit will operate until the push handle is manually pulled back up to the off position.

**TESTING PROGRAM** 

The American National Standards Institute (ANSI) states that all safety emergency equipment shall be activated on a weekly basis to flush the line and verify proper operation. Speakman Company furnishes a testing record tag (91-0635) with each unit. On this tag the date of inspection and the inspectors initials should be noted.

### **INSTALLATION:**

This unit is equipped with a cast floor flange drifted for three (3) mounting bolts. When ready to install, mark bolt holes at site and install suitable anchors.

When unit is fully assembled per instructions, place shower in position and bolt down tightly. Connect 1 1/4" supply line to inlet tee. The unit is now ready for test and operation.

### **OPERATION:**

The shower is operated by pulling down on a ring (self-closing valve) or a pull rod (ball valve). Once the valve is opened, the head will continue to discharge water until the valve is manually closed. This is done by upward pressure on the pull rod or until the ring is released on the self-closing valve.

To operate the eye or eye/face wash, push the handle to the rear of the unit. The units will continue to operate until the handle is manually pulled to the upward (off) position.

### MAINTENANCE:

The only portion of the units that may require maintenance are the valves. To replace the valves or seals, shut the water supply off, and reference the appropriate part sheet for the type valve you want to service.

Speakman Company furnishes a testing record tag (part #91-0635) with each unit On this tag the date of inspection and the inspectors initials can be noted. Test programs should be set up on a weekly basis.

CAUTION: Return to full off position following usage and/or test.

### **ASSEMBLY PROCEDURES:**

The first thing to check before assembly is the distance to your closest obstacle from the center of the stanchion (three bolt holes). If the dimension is less than 12", you should pre-assemble the (3) stanchion parts prior to floor mounting.


Providing you have clearance the best method would be to mount the bottom stanchion and assemble the rest after securing the base.

When assembling do not use wrenches on painted surfaces. You can use couplings and pipe to secure and gain leverage. Be sure and use pipe sealant on all threaded connections.

Review drawing to assure proper location of inlets, outlets, and accessories. The drain spud is adjustable, but in most cases it will not be necessary to adjust.

Installing the bowl for the eye or eye/face wash should be as follows:

(I)Rest the bowl on the drain spud, and make sure the washer for the strainer union is in place and loosely assemble coupling nut. (2) Once bowl is positioned correctly on spud, apply plumbers putty to drain strainer and secure with allen wrench. (3) Tighten coupling nut the rest of the way to the line strainer.







### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR FOOT PEDAL (H.F.O)



- ASSEMBLE U-BOLT HANGER AROUND STANCHION, AS SHOWN, BELOW TEE. BRACKET SHOULD FACE FORWARD AND BE PERPENDICULAR WITH CENTERLINE OF BOWL.
- ALIGN THROUGH HOLES IN FOOT TREDLE WITH HOLES IN THE BRACKET. MAKE SURE CHAIN S-HOOK CONNECTOR HOLE IS TO THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE BOWL. INSERT AND TIGHTEN BOLTS.
- REMOVE PUSH HANDLE NUT & HANDLE, PLACE LEVER (FLAT SIDE OUT) ON BALL VALVE SPINDLE AS SHOWN. REPLACE PUSH HANDLE AND TIGHTEN HANDLE NUT.
- SLIP CHAIN CONNECTOR THROUGH LEVER. PUSH HANDLE TO FULL OPEN POSITION. WITH THE FOOT TREDLE RESTING ON THE FLOOR, PULL CHAIN TAUGHT AND SLIP LINK INTO CONNECTOR.
- 5. PULL HANDLE TO FULL OFF POSITION.
  THIS SHOULD RAISE THE FOOT TREDLE
  UP SO THAT IT IS OFF THE FLOOR.
  ACTIVATE BALL VALVE BY STEPPING ON
  TREDLE. CHECK TO MAKE SURE VALVE
  IS FULLY OPEN. IF NOT, ADJUST CHAIN
  AT CONNECTOR. ONCE ADJUSTMENTS
  HAVE BEEN MADE AND UNIT IS
  FUNCTIONING PROPERLY, REMOVE
  EXTRA CHAIN LINKS TO PREVENT
  INTERFERENCE.





# BOWL ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- ASSEMBLE BOWL COMPONENTS AS SHOWN.
- ASSEMBLED, APPLY PLUMBERS PUTTY TO THE UNDERSIDE OF THE STRAINER LIP PUTTY IS OPTIONAL ON THE PLASTIC BOWL.
- 3. SLIP THE STRAINER THROUGH THE HOLE IN THE BOWL. AND SLIDE THE RUBBER WASHER OVER THE END SO THAT THE FLAT PORTION OF THE WASHER IS FACING THE BOWL.
- 4. HAND THREAD THE STRAINER INTO THE MOUNTING SPUD UNTIL TIGHT.
- 5. PROPERLY ALIGN THE BOWL TO WALL AND/OR STANCHION.
- 6. USING THE WRENCH HEX ROD PROVIDED, TIGHTEN THE STRAINER DOWN WHILE HOLDING THE BOWL ALIGNED.
- 7. WHEN COMPLETE, THE BOWL SHOULD BE RIGID AND NOT ROTATE.
